 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Foreign Adversary
 - 5 Communications Transparency Act".

5	(a) Definitions.—In this section:
6	(1) Appropriate national security agen-
7	CY.—The term "appropriate national security agen-
8	cy" has the meaning given the term in section 9 of
9	the Secure and Trusted Communications Networks
10	Act of 2019 (47 U.S.C. 1608).
11	(2) Commission.—The term "Commission"
12	means the Federal Communications Commission.
13	(3) COVERED COUNTRY.—The term "covered
14	country" means—
15	(A) the People's Republic of China;
16	(B) Russia;
17	(C) Iran;
18	(D) North Korea;
19	(E) Cuba; and
20	(F) Venezuela.
21	(4) COVERED ENTITY.—The term "covered en-
22	tity'' means—
23	(A) the government of a covered country;
24	(B) an entity organized under the laws of
25	a covered country or otherwise subject to the

1	jurisdiction of the government of a covered
2	country; and
3	(C) a subsidiary or affiliate of an entity
4	described in subparagraph (B) that is not orga-
5	nized under the laws of a covered country or
6	otherwise subject to the jurisdiction of the gov-
7	ernment of a covered country.
8	(b) Publication of List.—Not later than 120 days
9	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Commission
10	shall publish on the internet website of the Commission
11	a list of each entity—
12	(1) that holds—
13	(A) an authorization issued by the Com-
14	mission;
15	(B) a license issued by the Commission; or
16	(C) any other grant of authority issued by
17	the Commission; and
18	(2) either—
19	(A) any of the equity interest (or equiva-
20	lent thereof) of which is owned by a covered en-
21	tity; or
22	(B) that is not covered by subparagraph
23	(A) but that the Commission, in consultation
24	with an appropriate national security agency,
25	considers appropriate.

1 (c) Annual Updates.—The Commission shall up-

- 2 date the list published under subsection (b) not less fre-
- 3 quently than annually.
