11 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON ESTABLISHMENT OF SIMILAR PO12 SITIONS.

No Federal funds may be obligated or expended to
establish a position within the Department of Defense that
is the same as or substantially similar to—

16 (1) the position of Chief Diversity Officer, as
17 described in section 147 of title 10, United States
18 Code, as such section was in effect on the day before
19 the date of the enactment of this Act; or

(2) the position of Senior Advisor for Diversity
and Inclusion, as described in section 913(b) of the
William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (Public Law
116–283; 134 Stat. 3803), as such section was in ef-
