Purpose: To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to deny immigration benefits to any alien who carried out, participated in, planned, financed, supported, or otherwise facilitated the October 7, 2023 attacks against Israel.

AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. RUBIO to the amendment (No. 1388) proposed by Mrs. MURRAY (for herself and Mr. SCHUMER)

1 At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_.** **INELIGIBILITY FOR IMMIGRATION BENEFITS OF**  
2 **ALIENS WHO CARRIED OUT, PARTICIPATED**  
3 **IN, PLANNED, FINANCED, SUPPORTED, OR**  
4 **OTHERWISE FACILITATED ATTACKS AGAINST**  
5 **ISRAEL.**

6 (a) **SHORT TITLE.**—This section may be cited as the  
7 “No Immigration Benefits for Hamas Terrorists Act”.

8 (b) **PARTICIPANTS IN HAMAS TERRORISM AGAINST**  
9 **ISRAEL.**—Section 212(a)(3) of the Immigration and Na-  
10 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)) is amended—

11 (1) in subparagraph (B)(i), in the matter fol-  
12 lowing subclause (IX)—

13 (A) by inserting “Palestinian Islamic  
14 Jihad, or Hamas” after “Palestine Liberation  
15 Organization”; and

16 (B) by inserting “member,” after “rep-  
17 resentative,”; and

18 (2) by adding at the end the following:

19 “(H) **PARTICIPANTS IN HAMAS TERRORISM**  
20 **AGAINST ISRAEL.**—Any alien who carried out,  
21 participated in, planned, financed, afforded ma-  
22 terial support to, or otherwise facilitated any of  
23 the attacks against Israel initiated by Hamas  
24 beginning on October 7, 2023, is inadmissible.”.

25 (c) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section  
26 237(a)(4)(B) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8

1 U.S.C. 1227(a)(4)(B)) is amended by striking “subpara-  
2 graph (B) or (F)” and inserting “subparagraph (B), (F),  
3 or (H)”.

4 (d) INELIGIBILITY FOR RELIEF.—Section 241(b)(3)  
5 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1231(b)(3)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
7 lowing:

8 “(D) INELIGIBILITY FOR RELIEF.—Any  
9 alien who carried out, participated in, planned,  
10 financed, afforded material support to, or other-  
11 wise facilitated any of the attacks against Israel  
12 initiated by Hamas beginning on October 7,  
13 2023, shall be ineligible for any relief under the  
14 immigration laws, including under this section,  
15 section 208, and section 2242 of the Omnibus  
16 Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Ap-  
17 propriations Act, 1999 (and any regulations  
18 issued pursuant to such section).”.

19 (e) REPORT REQUIRED ON PARTICIPANTS IN HAMAS  
20 TERRORISM AGAINST ISRAEL.—Beginning not later than  
21 1 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, and  
22 annually thereafter, the Secretary of Homeland Security  
23 shall submit a report to Congress that identifies the num-  
24 ber of aliens who, during the period covered by the re-  
25 port—

1           (1) were found to be inadmissible under section  
2           212(a)(3)(H) of the Immigration and Nationality  
3           Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(H)); or

4           (2) were found to be removable pursuant to sec-  
5           tion 237(a)(4)(B) of the Immigration and Nation-  
6           ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(4)(B)).
