1 SEC. 2. COORDINATED MATERNAL HEALTH EFFORTS.

2 The Healthy People Maternal, Infant, and Child 3 Health Workgroup and the Maternal Health Working Group shall provide recommendations to the Secretary of 4 5 Health and Human Services (referred to in this section as the "Secretary") for establishing a formal coordinated 6 7 approach for monitoring maternal health efforts across the Department of Health and Human Services, including in rural and underserved areas, and the Secretary, not later 9 than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, shall 10 11 establish such an approach. Such approach may include 12 establishing a process for exchanging information and discussing relevant program efforts and outcomes across the 13 agency, during regular standing meetings, on a routine
