5 of this Act, the United States Postal Service shall des6 ignate a single, unique ZIP code for, as nearly as prac7 ticable, each of the following communities:

- 8 (1) Ocoee, Florida.
- 9 (2) Miami Lakes, Florida.
- 10 (3) Oakland, Florida.
