3	Section 487(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
4	(20 U.S.C. 1094(a)) is amended by adding at the end the

6	"(30) If a Confucius Institute (as defined in

1	"(C) removes the Chinese assistant direc-
2	tor position from the Confucius Institute;
3	"(D) subjects the staff and professors of
4	the Confucius Institute to appropriate back-
5	ground checks;
6	"(E) is publicly available in its entirety on-

8	"(F) does not have a confidentiality sec-
9	tion; and
10	"(G) provides that the institution has final
11	decision-making authority, including with re-
12	gard to conference themes, guest speakers, and
13	topics for events on campus at the institution.".
